AUGUST MEETING REPORTS - 8/15/2012

Officer and Committee Reports

Chairman – Peter Guadagni

- Thank you to San Mateo Master Marlins, officials and volunteers for conducting a great Championship meet.
- The Executive Committee approved Rob Heath as a Pacific Masters delegate to the USMS convention. The following is his delegate statement:
 - "I have been an active member of the Manatee Aquatic Masters for the past 9 years, and also as a coach for the team the past 2 years. My love for competitive swimming is exceeded only by my desire to become more involved in the sport as a career. I would bring to the convention over 50 years of competitive swimming and coaching experience, a passion for the sport, and a desire to spread the benefits of USMS to the public in general, and to PMS members specifically. I would also value the opportunity to help shape the future of the sport with like-minded individuals from across the country."
- Reminder that 2013 budget requests should be sent to the treasurer prior to the end of August.
- Reminder that proposals for Pacific Masters' by laws changes should be submitted prior to the next meeting.
- We have received the attached request from San Ramon Valley Livermore Aquatics (SRVLA) to provide financial assistance for them to start a Masters program. Providing financial assistance to start Masters clubs has been contemplated by Pacific Masters. The SRVLA Masters team would use Olympic pool at California High School. This facility is in close proximity to Bishop Ranch, an office park with 30,000 workers. The head coach would be Larry Baeder, a coach recommended by Joel Wilson, who attended our coach development planning meeting in April. The SRVLA proposal requests complete funding for pool time for a 25 week period (\$3,684). I prefer a declining level of support but would like to expand the assistance to cover the head coach's salary. My suggestion is we provide full funding for the proposed program for first 2 months, two-thirds funding for the next 2 months, and one-third funding for months 5 and 6. Thereafter, they would be on their own. The cost of this approach would be \$3,552. If the new club attracts 75 net new members to Pacific Masters the funding would pay for itself after 3 years. I request the board to approve a \$3,600 over budget expenditure and authorize me to negotiate the specific terms of the financial assistance. I am looking at this as an experiment and a model for how we can provide assistance to other new clubs in the future. Even with this expenditure we will probably end the year under our approved expense budget.
- Eric van Boer and I are exploring how Pacific Masters can use Amplifinity (<u>www.amplifinity.com</u>) to grow our membership.

Zone Chair - Michael Moore

I received an email from John Traynor concerning having a Zone Open Water Championships. Attached is a copy of the proposal. In many respects, then does not work well for the Hawaii and Pacific LMSCs. Our LMSC is about 450 mi by 450 mi and our zone is over 2500 Miles from one end to another, about the same distance from San Francisco to New York.

The Zone chairs were part of organizing the survey of LMSCs minimum standards. Pacific did very well.

Open Water - Glenda Carroll

Meet Operations - Barry Fasbender

2012 PacMasters LC Championships. There were 587 swimmers entered in the meet. This is second only to the 607 swimmer we had in 2006 just before we hosted the FINA World Championships. The meet was well received and everyone enjoyed six warmup lanes rather than one. We had a few operational issues we need to think about.

Many swimmers swam much faster than their entered times. This resulted in heats that were not as completive as they should have been. It also caused the meet to run much longer because faster swimmers in earlier heats place

slower swimmers in later heats. What is the best way to address this issue?

We had some check in problems with the individual mixed events due to the way that Meet Manager works. If a mixed event is included in the session report that lists the expected start time for each event, that event will not be listed on the check-in report for women and men. This happened on Sunday and several swimmers checked in for all their events on either the women or men check-in sheet, but missed the mixed check-in sheet. This resulted in creating an extra heat for these swimmers. I discussed this with Franz and we came up with a recommended way to handle this in the future for meets that have a few mixed events. We need to have separate events for women and men so those events that are swum mixed will be listed on the check-in sheets for both women and men. We will then copy these events to dummy events (e.g. events 1 and 2 would be copied to events 101 and 102). This allows us to have a copy of the original data in case we have to restore it. After the check in sheets are printed, we will change the women's event to a mixed event and combine the women and men's events (e.g. event 2 will be combined into event 1 and the swimmers in event 2 will be deleted). When the results are generated, the women's results go into the odd event number and the men's results go into the following event number.

Registration - Nancy Ridout

As of August 15th, we have registered 10,537 swimmers and 124 clubs. We have gained 338 swimmers since our last meeting. Membership totals for this time period in past years are as follows: 10,384 swimmers and 125 clubs as of 8/16/2011; 10,346 swimmers & 125 clubs as of 8/17/10; 10,221 & 126 as of 8/19/09: 9,382 & 120 as of 8/18/08: 9,431 & 112 as of 8/22/07; 9598 & 117 as of 8/19/06; 9,086 & 105 as of 8/20/05; 8,963 & 111 as of 8/21/04; 9,306 & 109 as of 8/25/03; 9,573 & 119 as of 8/28/02; 9,122 swimmers and 119 as of 8/24/01; 8,537 & 111 as of 8/11/00; 8,144 & 101 as of 8/8/99; 7,927 & 101 as of 8/26/98; 7,716 & 107 as of 8/22/97; 7,159 & 108 as of 8/16/96; 6,378 & 97 as of 8/11/95; 6,171 & 93 as of 8/11/94; 5,938 & 88 as of 8/12/93; 5,847 & 80 as of 8/7/92.

Clubs may begin renewing for 2013 in October and I'll be sending out a message and the new form to that effect after the convention to ensure the information is correct and up to date. As of 9/1/12, new members will be able to pay a reduced fee of \$34 when joining for the remainder of 2011. Any swimmers paying the full fee will be sent a \$12 voucher with their cards to use for reducing their 2013 fee. We need to determine the Pacific Masters fee for 2012 in order to have our form ready and the software updated for online registration. Currently the club fee is \$65, and the transfer fee is \$3. Registration materials will be sent out to each currently registered club in early October.

After tonight's endorsements of the SCY, SCM, and LCM Championship meets, I will be able to draw up a meeting calendar for your approval at our September meeting.

Top Ten and Records - Nancy Ridout

Now that the LC Championships have concluded, I will prepare the Pacific Masters LC Top Ten and submit it to USMS for inclusion in the USMS Top Ten. I am in the process of updating the SCM records for the Modesto meet this weekend and the fall SCM meets.

Scheduling - John Morales

I sent out the request for Champ bids a month ago. I group emailed anyone who had hosted a meet, and singularly emailed anyone who had hosted a Champs Meet in the past few years. Michael has also included requests in his weekly e-blasts. Results so far are thus:

SCY- Walnut Creek has submitted the only bid for April 5-7 at Campolindo High School

LCM- I spent the better part of this past weekend trying to get a commitment from San Mateo. Tom Reudy, their coach, and Jeff Enright, active SMM swimmer were excited about the past weekend, but were uncommitted at this time. I will contact them one more time before our Wednesday meeting.

SCM- I have talked to John King and Kerry O' Brien about WCM hosting. I also emailed Chris Stewart, past meet director, but did not hear back. I do not believe there is a problem with them hosting the meet, I just have not been given a date. No other teams have bid to host this event.

I realize the bylaws require a vote on the 2013 Champ Meets at this month's meeting. The Long Course Meet appears to be the biggest challenge, but I am optimistic San Mateo masters will host again. I would like to get the Champ Meets set in stone, because other teams are looking to schedule their events.
